

# FAQs

## Where can I go to hack?

The entire library is open to use, feel free to venture upstairs.

Please be aware that the library will be open to all W&M students on Saturday 10am-8p, and Sunday after 10am.

Talking in a normal voice is fine on the first floor and in the basement. The second floor is meant for quiet whispering, and the third floor is meant to be silent. Please follow these rules during normal hours.

## Where can I go to sleep?

The above rules being said, the third floor is an excellent sleeping space.

## How do I use the 3D Printers?

You'll have to have one of our volunteers with you the entire time your creation is printing. Post in the #makerspace channel and someone will help you out.

## How can I check out hardware?


Once the event starts, you can browse and reserve available hardware here: <https://hardware.mlh.io/>

## Where can I use the drones?

You can use the drones only in the areas marked on the map below. Do not fly the drones inside of the building. Please be responsible when flying the drones, and go to the other designated area if there is another group using an area.



## Are there gender neutral restrooms?

Yes! There are two in the coffee shop on the first floor, and two in the basement near the copy center.

## Do I need to wear my wristband the entire time?

Yup. If you leave the building and try to come back when it is normally closed, you will need to be wearing a TribeHacks wristband to be allowed back in.
